## Public Health Conducting Health Assessment Survey of Greene County; Requesting Public Input, Focus Group Meetings Scheduled

**XENIA, OH** – The team at Greene County Public Health has begun surveying Greene County residents as part of a community health assessment process.

The anonymous survey, available on the agency's social media platforms and website (please scan the QR code), asks participants to answer questions about their general health, risk and protective health factors, and access to healthcare. The results of the data and information collected will create a snapshot of the health of Greene County. This will guide many public and private agencies in their program planning over the next several years by identifying key health problems. The final community health assessment report will be published in the spring of 2026, at which time the results will be used to prioritize needs and create a community health improvement plan.
