Free Medical, Dental, and Vision Clinic Coming to Beavercreek to Serve Dayton-Area Residents

BEAVERCREEK, Ohio — Access to healthcare remains a challenge for many families across the Miami Valley, and a free community health clinic is stepping in to help.

On **Friday, June 19, 2026, and Sunday, June 21, 2026**, residents of Dayton and surrounding communities will have access to **free medical, dental, and vision services** at **Beavercreek Seventh-day Adventist Church, 670 Grange Hall Road, Beavercreek, Ohio**.

The clinic will provide services on a first-come, first-served basis, with no insurance or payment required.

Available services include:

- Vision exams and prescription glasses
- Dental cleanings, fillings, and extractions
- Medical screenings and basic healthcare services

The event is designed to help individuals and families who may be uninsured, underinsured, or facing barriers to accessing routine healthcare.

"Healthcare shouldn't be out of reach. Many people in our community delay or go without needed care because of cost. This clinic helps connect residents with essential services that can improve their quality of life and overall health," says Pastor Delthony Gordon, Director of Adventist Community Services of the Ohio Conference of Seventh-day Adventists and local pastor of the Beavercreek Church.

Local healthcare access affects everyone. Untreated vision problems can impact school and work performance, untreated dental issues can lead to serious health complications, and preventive medical screenings can identify concerns before they become emergencies. Organizers believe that improving access to healthcare strengthens families and contributes to a healthier, more resilient community.

Community members are encouraged to arrive early, as services will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis and demand is expected to be high.
