Greene County Public Health Offers Last Opportunity This Year for Food Protection Training

XENIA, OH—The Food Protection Program through Environmental Health Services at Greene County Public Health is offering a final class of the ServSafe® Level 2 Food Protection Training class, **October 20th and 27th** (2-day class).

The **ServSafe® Level 2 Certification in Food Protection Manager's Course** is a 15-hour course that details the study of food safety procedures and prevention of foodborne illnesses. Upon successful completion, participants in this course will receive national, state, and local recognition as certified in food safety. This course requirement applies to all managers of Risk Level III and IV Food Service Operations (FSOs) and Retail Food Establishments (RFEs). At least one employee who "has supervisory and management responsibility and the authority to direct and control food preparation and service," must obtain the ServSafe® Level 2 Certification in the Food Protection Manager's course.

This Level 2 class will be held at the main office of Greene County Public Health, located at 360 Wilson Drive in Xenia, on **October 20th and 27th (2-day class)**. Cost is \$150 per person. ***You must register a minimum of 2 weeks in advance of the class to guarantee a seat in that class.*** The cost for a retest or for the exam only is \$75 per person (only held on the second day of the class, October 27th). Class size is limited. This two-day class is a minimum of 15 hours in length.
