Greene County Safe Communities Reports Five Traffic Fatalities in 4th Quarter (July - September) of Fiscal Year

XENIA, OH -- The Greene County Safe Communities program reports **five fatal crashes in the fourth quarter of the grant's fiscal year, 2025** (July - September), bringing the total to fourteen (14) fatal crashes for the fiscal year, resulting in fifteen (15) deaths.

The coalition wants to remind all drivers to please put their phones down, avoid all distractions, buckle up, drive sober, and obey all traffic signs and signals. The Safe Communities Coalition will continue to collaborate with schools, businesses, and the public to provide educational materials and information, ensuring Greene County citizens remain safe on the roadways. The safety of Greene County residents while traveling is the Coalition's biggest concern.

The Safe Communities program was developed to help communities reduce traffic injuries and deaths, increase safety awareness, decrease the cost of traffic-related injuries, and increase the number of people involved in keeping communities safe.
