Greene County Safe Communities Coalition Announces the Save A Life Tour™ Coming To Beavercreek, April 2

BEAVERCREEK, OH — The Greene County Safe Communities program is bringing the *International Save A Life Tour™* to Beavercreek High School on April 2, 2026, from 9:25 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

This program teaches students about safe driving in a hands-on way. Students will use virtual reality simulators to see how dangerous it is to drive while distracted or impaired.

The Save A Life Tour™ is a high-impact program that shows how poor choices behind the wheel can lead to serious or even deadly crashes. It focuses on:

- Distracted and impaired driving
- Driver experience
- Unsafe driving behavior
- Seat belt use

Students will learn through videos, speakers, and interactive simulator activities. They will also complete short surveys and receive items like a pledge card and wristband to remind them to make safe choices.

Local media and community partners are invited to attend and see the program in action. Visitors must sign up ahead of time and check in at the school's front office on the day of the event.
