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Public Health Announces Spooktacular Sock Drive

GREENE COUNTY, OH – Greene County Public Health announced that it will hold a “Spooktacular Sock Drive” October 1-27 to collect new socks for local children in partnership with HTC (formerly known as Hannah’s Treasure Chest).

HTC is a nonprofit organization dedicated to enriching the lives of children in need. Founded in 2001, HTC provides clothing, shoes, books, toys, hygiene items, and other essential items through a network of community partner agencies. These items support children and families throughout Southwest Ohio who need extra help.

“A pair of socks may seem like a small and simple gift, but for a child who needs them, that small gift can mean comfort, dignity, and knowing that someone cares,” said Laurie Fox, Public Information Officer for Greene County Public Health. “It’s a wonderful reminder that even the simplest acts of kindness can make a lasting difference.”

New socks of all sizes are welcome, with a focus on children from birth through age 12. Donations may be placed in the collection bin in the lobby of Greene County Public Health, located at 360 Wilson Drive in Xenia. Hours are Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

“Our partnership with HTC allows us to connect families with resources that can make a real difference in their everyday lives,” said Stephanie Sanders, Community Health Services Program Manager at Greene County Public Health. “When organizations come together to support children and families, we can reach more people, meet more needs, and strengthen the community we all call home.”
